Environment:

During the year, we all need to clean debris, grass clippings, trash and leaves on our properties, as well as at the street curbs in front of our homes, particularly around street drains to minimize clogging these drains during rains or snow melt. This is a problem for all of us, and with all of us keeping up with cleaning storm drain debris we also help the environment.

Westgate Community Survey Still Open

In June, the community association created an online survey to request community input on the role of the association in community affairs. To date, 39 responses have been received. Thanks to those of you who responded. A more detailed article about the survey will appear in a future newsletter. Here are a few highlights:

The top choice for Board action was to create a Neighborhood Watch. **We have! See notice of Citizens' Patrol meeting, with date, time and place in the Events section on page 1.**

The nearly unanimous response for Board priorities was advocacy for residents with local government agencies. Other popular choices were to organize community social events and address property care problems in the community. Can you give some time to one of these efforts? If so, please email us.

You could shop for a day without joining the Coop, at the Immanuel United Church of Christ, 1905 Edmondson Ave. Catonsville.
